SECOND SCRIPTURE READING Mark 1:1–11

The beginning of the good news of Jesus Christ. ² As it is written in the prophet Isaiah, "See, I am sending my messenger ahead of you, who will prepare your way, 3 the voice of one crying out in the wilderness: 'Prepare the way of the Lord; make his paths straight,' " 4 so John the baptizer appeared in the


